

## CORE VACCINES

Core vaccines are considered vital to all pets based on risk of exposure, severity of disease or transmissibility to humans.

**FOR DOGS:** Vaccines for canine parvovirus, distemper, canine hepatitis and rabies are considered core vaccines. Non-core vaccines are given depending on the dog's exposure risk. These include vaccines against *Bordetella bronchiseptica* (Kennel Cough), *Borrelia burgdorferi* (Lymes Disease), and *Leptospira* bacteria.

TICKS

**FOR CATS:** Vaccines for panleukopenia (feline distemper), feline calicivirus, feline herpesvirus type I (rhinotracheitis) and rabies are considered core vaccines. Non-core vaccines are given depending on the cat's lifestyle; these include vaccines for feline leukemia virus, *Bordetella*, *Chlamydomphila felis*.
